In an effort to raise funds to address the ongoing shortfall in funding from the Department of Education, the Board of Management of Tuamgraney National School introduced a School Lotto in February 2022. This has proved to be a very successful fundraiser for the school. We are currently compiling a new list of participants for the coming year, with the first draw taking place at the end of March/April. At this stage, we are seeking expressions of interest to determine if this will continue to be a viable fundraising initiative for the year ahead.

How the Lotto Works:

- ◆ Participants sign up to a monthly €10 draw for the year, or €120 annually.
- ◆ The draw is based on the bonus ball in the Irish Lotto on the last Wednesday of each month.
- ◆ Each participant is assigned a random number each month and will be informed of their number in advance of the draw.
- ◆ The monthly prize is €150.

then the power of the sea will uphold them.


so believers entrust their lives
