Biodiversity Project

'*Tuamgraney Tidy Towns* in conjunction with the Biodiversity Officer with Clare County Council Barry O'Loughlin, the parish priest Kieran and Bishop Fintan Monahan are carrying out biodiversity actions on the church grounds as part of the 'Return to Nature Clare Church Biodiversity Project'. St. Josephs Church is participating in the project this year (along with 23 other churches in Clare). Biodiversity actions include installing bird nest boxes, installing bat roost boxes, planting pollinator friendly bulbs, adopting a pollinator friendly mowing regime to promote wildflowers on a section of the church grounds to provide a nectar and pollen source for declining pollinators). A section of the lawn may look different than usual with the longer grass, but please bear with us, as the bee and butterfly population is declining nationally & we all need to do our part to protect them!'

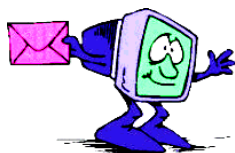
