PARISH NOTES



Resumption of Mass

The Government has announced special concessions with regard to religious services at level 3 which will be reviewed in January. This allows up to 50 people to attend Mass with the following measures in place:

- 2 metre social distancing members of the same household should sit together
- Face coverings must be worn
- Gathering outside of church before or after Mass is not permitted.
- The building must be well-ventilated.
- Funerals and Weddings are still limited to 25 people please respect this number.

To help us maintain these protocols we would respectfully ask that you attend only one Mass over a weekend thereby allowing others to attend. Thanks to all of you who follow these requests and thereby help to reduce the spread of infection. We are very grateful for your efforts in the community that help people to help one another. (See panel left for mass times during this period of restrictions). Please keep in mind that capacity is limited to 50 at masses. Masses are also available online weekdays at 10am and on Sunday at 9.30am.

Christmas Masses: Because of the capacity restrictions, the family Mass in Bodyke on Christmas Eve will be online only. Christmas arrangements are as follows and we remind you that no more than 50 are allowed to attend.

Christmas Eve

- 6pm Family Liturgy for Christmas online only
- 9pm Bodyke Church restricted to 40

Christmas Day

- 9am Tuamgraney Church restricted to 40 (please note this mass is already fully booked)
- 10.30am Bodyke Church restricted to 40

The restrictions of numbers for mass especially during the Christmas season make our planning very difficult and inevitably will cause inconvenience and upset to some if not many of our parishioners. We would ask for your understanding and co-operation as we work within government guidelines to provide a safe environment for all in our worship. Keep in mind that with capacity restricted to 50 that a good alternative is joining us online for our services or listening over the radio link. If you are planning to attend one of our Christmas Masses we would ask you to please contact the Parish Office (087 1498763) in advance, and preferably during opening hours on Tuesdays & Thursdays, to provide your contact tracing details and indicate which Mass you wish to attend. We would hope that all families with children will participate in the Christmas Eve liturgy which is online only. The 9pm Mass in Bodyke will have an adults priority. The restricted capacity for Christmas Masses is 40 as this will allow for those directly involved in the liturgy to be included in the larger group numbers.

The symbols on the tree, as well as the tree itself, are based on lines of scripture telling us of the family line of Jesus and of the various prophets who foretold of his coming. The first Jesse trees were images, tapestries or carvings that were used to teach people Bible stories about Jesus. One of the earliest examples dates from the 11th Century in an illuminated manuscript, similar to the Book of Kells.

Tuamgraney Park & Christmas Lights Fundraiser

The renovation works in the Memorial Park are complete, the Christmas lights are on and the park is now back open. These works have been made possible due to a successful application for funding under the Town & Village Renewal Scheme 2020.
