Celebration of Mass: During the week the Irish Bishops published guidelines on celebration of Mass and sacraments which are due to recommence from June 29th. We will be making arrangements in our parishes to ensure that these guidelines are followed as closely as possible. In the coming weeks we will publish these arrangements in the newsletter and online. We ask for your understanding and co-operation so that we can make a safe return to celebrating the sacraments.

Meanwhile our churches are currently open for private prayer and visits; please use the sanitisers provided and try to keep your visit short and within physical distance guidelines. Thanks to all who have helped to keep our churches open at this time.

When masses restart we will of course be accepting bookings for Anniversary Masses. However, because we have not had Masses since March it will be necessary to include a number of intentions at the same Mass. There will be a number of Memorial Masses and First Anniversary Masses to be held to which priority will be given for booking requests at masses outside of regular Sundays. Your understanding will be much appreciated.

#### **Confirmation and Holy Communion**

We hope to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for Bodyke & Tuamgraney NS candidates on Saturday 29th August at 11am and the Sacrament of First Holy Communion on Saturday 26th September also at 11am. Both celebrations will be in the Church of the Assumption Bodyke and will be held in line with Diocesan and HSE guidelines and will have restricted numbers attending. Please pray for all the children involved whose celebrations have been deferred this year due to the Covid-19 crisis. To help as wide a congregation as possible to participate in the celebrations of Confirmation and Holy Communion we are trying to put in place facilities for online viewing/webcast. Any technical help would be very much appreciated. Please contact Fr David for further information.

Although the Parish Office is currently closed to the public, you can still get Mass Cards and Bouquets there on Thursdays between 9am and 1pm. You can also drop in your Weekly and Special Collection Envelopes. Thank you for your continued generosity.
