As current health guidelines limit church capacity 50 people, please note that the ceremony will be restricted to those involved in the celebration. Mass will be as usual at 9.30am in Tuamgraney and 7pm in Bodyke on Saturday.

Anyone who is in possession of a **front door key to Tuamgraney Parish House**, and who is not using it at present, is asked to please return same during Parish Office opening hours. Thank you.

A reminder that the capacity of churches is limited to no more than 50 people at present under HSE and government guidelines. This applies to all liturgies and gatherings in church. Please help us to observe this limit. Also, if you have been to mass during the week there is no obligation to go again on Sunday and this would free up space for those who cannot attend Mass during the week and who wish to attend at weekends. Wearing of face masks in church is now recommended by the Irish bishops. Those who are reading and celebrants do not have to wear them throughout the liturgy. Remember, if you feel unwell or have a cold do not attend church. Everyone intending to receive Holy Communion must go to the priest or Eucharistic Minister at the sanctuary unless otherwise advised.

Planning to get married in 2021? You need to give at least six months notice for the completion of church and civil papers and so it would be a good idea to contact Fr. David to chat through the necessary requirements. This applies whether you are getting married in the parish, elsewhere in Ireland or overseas.
