#### **Public Celebration of Mass**

In View of the Government Statement on Covid-19 and the need to avoid indoor public gatherings of more than 100 people, and the difficulty of guaranteeing this in practice, following consultation Bishop Fintan Monahan has decided as follows:

<u>All</u> public Masses in this diocese, Sundays and weekdays (with the exception of Funeral Masses and the Celebration of Marriage) are suspended until March 29th or until further notice.

- Scariff Bay FM (88.3 FM) at 11.00am
- Clare FM at 9.00am

We would like to stress to you that we will be working within strict medical protocols to ensure there is no risk either to you or the volunteer. As part of this, we will not be entering your home and we will be following the social distancing and other recommendation set up by the HSE.

Your exchanges with us will remain confidential. Your information will not be held or shared.
