Lay Ministers

Due to current restrictions Lay Ministers and Altar Servers are not required at present.

Bodyke NS Board of Management and Parents Association wish to highlight concerns about safety on the public road in the vicinity of the school. There is great concern for the safety of children being dropped off and collected each day and the hope is that a solution can be found before there is a serious accident. Since there is no designated parking area, parents and teachers must pull up onto the footpath to drop and pick up from school. With increasing volume and speed of traffic on the Bodyke-Limerick road it makes the situation as it currently stands dangerous for all and we would ask that this matter be taken with the urgency it deserves. Off-road parking and a safe turning area near the school are urgently required. Clare County Council and Clare TDs have been asked to look at how this might be made possible. Local community support is hugely valuable and we would urge you to sign a petition and help draw attention to this local issue. PARISH NOTES



Public Celebration of Mass: With level 5 restrictions still in place until the end of November the celebration of Mass is only available online or broadcast on radio and television. Locally Mass is broadcast online at 10am every day from the Church of the Assumption Bodyke. Churches remain open for private and personal prayer. If **funerals** take place they will be restricted to fewer than 25 in church. **Baptisms** are not currently permitted other than in the case of emergency.

The **Tree of Remembrance** will remain in Bodyke Church until the end of November and you can still put the names of your deceased loved ones on the leaves provided and hang them on the tree. Also, please leave your list of the dead back to Bodyke Church or the parish office so that we can remember them at our live streamed masses each morning at 10am.

A **Mass of Remembrance** for all who died in Raheen Community Nursing Hospital will be held on this Saturday, 21st November, at 3pm. Due to current restrictions it is not open to the public but can be watched online via the link on the parish website.
