Due to Covid-19 restrictions no Lay Ministers will be required for the next few weeks. Sincere thanks to those who fulfilled their duty in this regard in recent months.

Collection Envelopes: During these weeks when the public celebration of Mass is not permitted you may wish to drop your weekly or Holy Souls envelopes (including your lists of deceased loved ones) at the Tuamgraney office on Tuesday or Thursday or at the Parish House in Bodyke. Your continued support is greatly appreciated.

November 1st is the Feast of All Saints and November 2nd is the Feast of All Souls. A special online ceremony will be broadcast from the Cathedral in Ennis on Sunday November 1st at 3pm. Mass will be broadcast online as usual from Bodyke Church both mornings at 10am.

Mass will be offered daily for the Holy Souls. If you wish to include your list of deceased relatives and friends please drop the lists to Tuamgraney Parish Office or Bodyke Parish House.

Public Celebration of Mass

With level 5 restrictions now in place until the end of November the celebration of Mass is only available online or broadcast on radio and television. Locally Mass is broadcast online at 10am every day from the Church of the Assumption Bodyke. Visit www.bodyketuamgraneyparish.ie and follow the link for Mass. Churches are remaining open for private and personal prayer. If **funerals** take place they will be restricted to fewer than 25 in church. **Baptisms** are not permitted during this time other than in the case of emergency.

Month of the Holy Souls
