

#### **PARISH NOTES**



Next Friday, 7th August, is the first Friday of the month. Mass will be in Bodyke at 10am on Friday morning and calls to the sick and housebound will take place during the day. By attending this Mass you will have satisfied your Sunday obligation and therefore there is no need to attend other Masses over the weekend. Please keep this in mind so as to allow the maximum capacity at weekend Masses. Please keep in mind that at the present time **Holy Communion must be received in the hand**. Thank you for your co-operation.

**Cemetery Mass:** A mass for the deceased of the parish will take place in St. Coolan's Cemetery on Wednesday August 26th at 7.30pm. Please observe social distancing guidelines if attending. Blessing of graves in all our cemeteries will take place as usual in November.

For all those grieving the loss of a loved one at this time, the lines below may be of some consolation:

With the resumption of Masses we are accepting bookings for Anniversary Masses. However, it is necessary to include a number of intentions at the same Mass. There will be a number of Memorial Masses and First Anniversary Masses to be held to which priority will be given for booking requests at masses outside of regular Sundays. Your understanding much appreciated.

The Sacrament of Confirmation for Bodyke & Tuamgraney NS candidates will be celebrated on Saturday 29th August at 11am and the Sacrament of First Holy Communion on Saturday 26th September also at 11am. Both celebrations will be in the Church of the Assumption Bodyke and will be held in line with Diocesan and HSE guidelines and will have restricted numbers attending. Please pray for all the children involved whose celebrations have been deferred this year due to the Covid-19 crisis. To help as wide a congregation as possible to participate in the celebrations of Confirmation and Holy Communion we are trying to put in place facilities for online viewing/webcast. #### New Audio Visual at St. Cronan's Church
