Sacraments 2020

Unfortunately it has been necessary to defer the celebration of First Holy Communion and as we await clear guidelines from the HSE & the diocese as to reopening of churches and gatherings of people we are unable to fix a new date for the celebrations. However, general opinion and our hope would be that we will have a celebration of First Holy Communion in late September/early October.

The intention was to celebrate Confirmation on May 31st following its earlier postponement and again this will depend on advice from both HSE & Bishop Fintan. My sincerest hope is that we will be able to celebrate the Sacrament before the present Confirmation candidates go to secondary school. Families will be contacted directly and information posted through our website and newsletter as soon as possible.

The parish very much regrets the inconvenience caused by this and the closure of churches. But please bear in mind that these things are happening because of the efforts to stop the transmission of COVID-19 and every effort must be made by all of us for the importance of public health and safety. We see that some are not

following the guidelines and this is not helping to protect the vulnerable and frontline staff who are doing such wonderful work in difficult times. Keep in mind that in following the guidelines it will help to ease the restrictions for everyone. If you don't, the crisis-related restrictions will continue. Please think of the wider community and especially those most at risk.
