

Update on Mass attendance

Due to the continued delay in introducing phase 4 of the easing of restrictions, the current Mass timetable will remain in place. A maximum of 50 are allowed at indoor gatherings so to ensure that as many people as possible can attend Mass at the weekend, keep in mind that by attending Mass during the week you have fulfilled your Sunday obligation. These restrictions apply to all indoor Church gatherings at the present time and we ask that you keep following all social spacing guidelines at this time.

For the distribution of Holy Communion all those intending to receive must go to the priest or Eucharistic Minister at the sanctuary unless otherwise advised.

Cemetery Masses

A Mass for the deceased of the parish will take place in St. Coolan's Cemetery on Wednesday August 26th at 7.30pm. Please observe social distancing guidelines if attending. Blessing of graves in all our cemeteries will take place as usual in November.

The annual graveyard Mass in the new cemetery Ogonnelloe will be celebrated on Saturday August 15th.

With the resumption of Masses we are accepting bookings for Anniversary Masses. However, it is necessary to include a number of intentions at the same Mass. There will be a number of Memorial Masses and First Anniversary Masses to be held to which priority will be given for booking requests at masses outside of regular Sundays. Your understanding much appreciated.

The Sacrament of Confirmation for Bodyke & Tuamgraney NS candidates will be celebrated on Saturday 29th August at 11am and the Sacrament of First Holy Communion on Saturday 26th September also at 11am. Both celebrations will be in the Church of the Assumption Bodyke and will be held in line with Diocesan and HSE guidelines and will have restricted numbers attending. Please pray for all the children involved whose celebrations have been deferred this year due to the Covid-19 crisis. To help as wide a congregation as possible to participate in the celebrations of Confirmation and Holy Communion we are trying to put in place facilities for online viewing/webcast.
