We will broadcast the ceremonies as follows:

- **April 1st:** Holy Thursday Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper from St. Mary's O'gonnelloe at 7.30pm
- April 2nd: Good Friday Celebration of the Lord's Passion from St. Molua's O'gonnelloe at 3pm
- **April 3rd:** Holy Saturday Easter Vigil from St. Joseph's Tuamgraney at 9pm
- **April 4th:** Easter Sunday Mass from Church of the Assumption Bodyke at 10am.

Please note that due to current restrictions these ceremonies are not open to the public. You are welcome to visit our churches at any stage during the week for private prayer.
