Saints of the week

29th June Ss Peter and Paul - this is the day, traditionally considered to be the foundation day of Rome by Romulus.

1st July St. Oliver Plunkett, the last Catholic to die at Tyburn and the first of the Irish martyrs to be beatified. He was archbishop of Armagh from 1669 to 1681.

Reflection

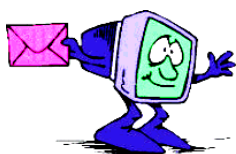
The power to heal
