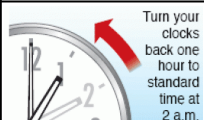

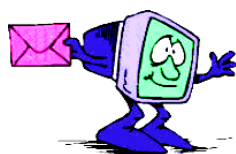
Bodyke Raheen Group Water Scheme Co-Operative Society Limited: Applications are invited for the position of Caretaker for the Bodyke Raheen Group Water Scheme, which supplies drinking water to over 70 households, business and commercial users in the Bodyke/Raheen area.

Duties include but not limited to: Network maintenance/repairs (planned and unplanned), water meter reading, leak detection, installation of meter connections, water quality testing and recording, liaising with all contractors and personnel involved in running the Scheme and administrative duties. Daily remote monitoring of the pumphouse/network is also required. The successful candidate, on occasion, may have to attend to emergencies outside of the normal working hours, so flexibility is key. The initial hours will be 7 hours/week and applicants are required to be flexible. The successful candidate will be working closely with the scheme Board and should have a proven track record in working as part of a team and must be equally capable of working on his/her own initiative.
