PARISH NOTES




Remembrance Mass for all who have passed away in the parish since last November takes place on this Saturday, November 13th, at 6.30pm in Tuamgraney Church.


Below is a reflection by John O'Donohue which you may wish to recite when visiting a family grave during November:
