Centenary Commemoration East Clare Brigade

On Monday August 1st a Commemoration will take place to remember Captain Mattie McGrath (Annaghneal), his brother Dinny, and the comrades of the 6th Battalion, East Clare Brigade. The day will commence with Mass in SS. Peter & Paul Church Tulla at 12noon, followed by the blessing of Cpt. Mattie's grave in St. Mochulla's cemetery Tulla. Refreshments will then be served. At 4pm, near Fortane Cross, a plaque will be unveiled and a wreath laid in memory of the East Clare Brigade. All are welcome to attend this Commemoration.

Reflection

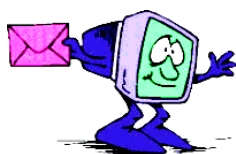
Heavenly glory
