The Annual Matt Talbot Novena will continue on Wednesday 29th March at 7pm in Tulla Church with Mass and Benediction. Fr. Ger Jones, who is currently ministering in the Abbey Pastoral Area, will lead us in prayer and reflection. There will be a special blessing of car and house keys at this evenings Novena. Attending this Novena could be your Lenten resolution.

**Commemoration** will be held for Pádraig Cadhla (1875 -1948), who lived in the parish and taught in both Bodyke N.S. (1915 -1918) and Tuamgraney N.S. (1919 -1941). A plaque to honour his contribution to the promotion of the Irish language will be unveiled at Tuamgraney National School on Friday 31st March at 10.30am. The plaque has been sponsored by Craobh Chonradh na Gaeilge Oirthear an Chláir and Coláiste na Rinne. Padraig was an activist in Conradh na Gaeilge since the early 1900s and was a co-founder of Ring College, Co. Waterford. Among his many achievements he was the first person to translate the children's classic 'Alice in Wonderland' into the Irish language and, with others, he established the Irish language newspaper An Sguab one hundred years ago. All parishioners are welcome to attend the ceremony which has been generously facilitated through the cooperation of the Board of Management and the Principal of Tuamgraney N.S., Ms Marie Moroney.

The amount collected in the church gate collection by Conradh na Gaeilge Oirthear an Chláir in Bodyke on St. Patrick's Day was €177. The money will be used for the promotion of Irish language activities in the area. Go raibh míle maith agaibh!

A Scholarship Scheme funded by Foras na Gaeilge and valued at €200 to cover costs of a Gaeltacht course is now open to applicants. To apply for a scholarship adult learners only have to answer the following 3 questions:

- 1. Who are you and what is your background with the Irish language?
- 2. Why do you wish to attend a Gaeltacht course this summer and which course do you have in mind?
- 3. Why do you need a scholarship and how would the support of this funding help?
