resume on Wednesday July 5th

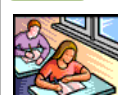


**The Peter's Pence and Diocesan Needs

have I grieved over lost time.

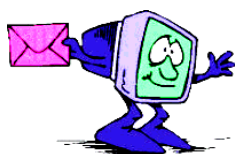
But it is never lost, my Lord.
