#### May is Safeguarding Month

Pope Francis reminded us that, 'in the Confiteor, we ask forgiveness not only for the wrong we have done, but also for the good we have failed to do.' In the past, the Catholic Church in Ireland failed in its duty to protect children and young people. Church policies have focused on establishing consistent standards to prevent abuse and assist the Church on its journey to learn from the mistakes of the past and ensure that children's safety is a core part of its mission.

Tulla History Group will be holding their final History talk before their summer recess on Monday 12th May at 8pm in Tulla Courthouse. The topic is 'A Social and Cultural History of Memorial Cards'. The speaker will be Dr. Salvador Ryan who will be speaking on the tradition and rituals of Memorial cards in Ireland. Dr. Ryan is a Professor of Ecclesiastical History at St. Patrick's Pontifical University, Maynooth. His interests are in Popular religion and ritual in late medieval and early modern Europe, and especially Gaelic Ireland as well as Medieval and early modern hagiography (the writing of the lives of Saints). We do hope you will join us on the 12th May for what promises to be a very informative and visual presentation by Dr. Ryan.
